A Catfish could never **me-ow**.

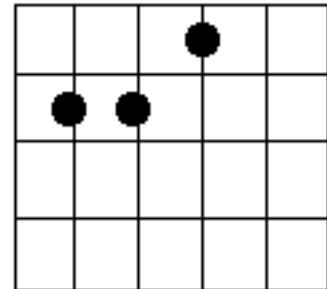

With the basketball nose on his **face**!

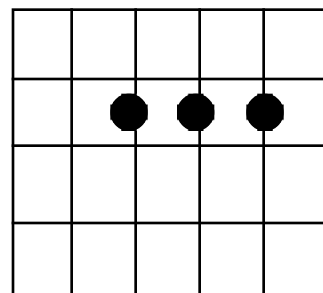
